Pursuant to Article 37 of the Higher Education Act (Official Gazette of the Republic of Slovenia, No. 32/2012 ZVŠ - UPB7, 40/2012-ZUJF, 57/2012-ZPCP-2D, 109/2012, 85/2014 and 75/16) and Article 49 of the Statute of the Euro-Mediterranean University (hereinafter EMUNI), at its 34<sup>th</sup> correspondence session on 15 October 2019, the Senate of the EMUNI adopted the following

## ACADEMIC CALENDAR 2019/2020

The Academic Calendar determines:

- a) educational work and exam periods,
- b) educational work-free days and
- c) important events and meetings of bodies.

### a) Organized educational work and exam periods

The academic year runs from 1 October 2019 to 30 September 2020.

In the academic year 2019/2020 EMUNI will carry out 30 weeks of organized forms of educational work, namely (see Table 1):

- 2 semesters, first in the range of 12 weeks, and the second in the range of 18 weeks.
- 3 examination periods of a total duration of 8 weeks, which take place after each semester and in the autumn period.

In the case of implementation of advanced/upgrading study programmes, they can be performed outside the defined semesters, and at least two examination dates shall be provided for each course. Details of such programme are defined in its implementation plan.

### b) Educational work-free days

Educational work-free days are all public holidays in accordance with the Law on Holidays and work-free days in the RS (Official Gazette 12/2005-UPB1, 52/2010, 40/2012-ZUJF, 19/2015 and 83/16). In planning the organized educational work and examination periods (point a)), some of the most important holidays that come from other cultures are already considered.

### c) Important events and body sessions

Table 2 provides a timetable for major events and body sessions at EMUNI important for students and higher education teachers.
