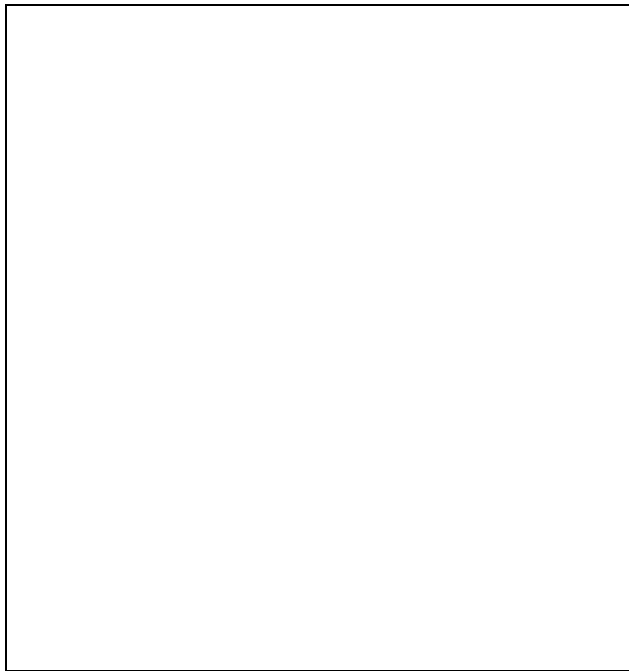

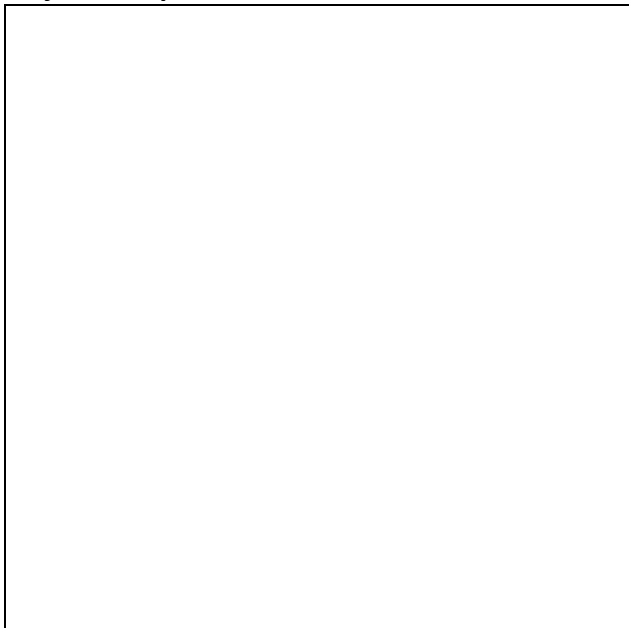

The aims of the course are

- 1) to provide students with information on the changing cultural constructions of gender identities in different societies making them aware of gender as a socio-cultural artefact
- 2) to make students aware of the role of gender in selected historical contexts
- 3) to make students aware of the changing categories used by scholars, and particularly historians, while focusing on gender and gender-related issues
- 4) to make students aware of the main historical approaches to the study of gender
- 5) to make student aware of the relationships of care, gender and citizenship
