**CALL FOR APPLICANTS FOR THE CO-FINANCING OF  
STUDY and TRAINEESHIP MOBILITY  
FOR THE ACADEMIC YEAR 2020/2021**

The Erasmus+ is co-funded by the European Commission as part of the **Lifelong Learning programme**. It exists to promote **student and staff mobility** in higher education, principally within the EU.

This call is for students EMUNI University wanting to conduct a study/traineeship mobility in one of the HEIs/companies in Europe. Erasmus+ programme enables you to:

- 1) **study** (Student Mobility for Studies),
- 2) **traineeship** (Student Mobility for Traineeships) or
- 3) both combined.

in Europe for a semester or a full year as part of your studies.

In doing so, this measure pursues the following objectives of the mobility:

- Improving learning competencies,
- Increasing employability and employment prospects,
- Increasing initiative and entrepreneurship,
- Improving language skills,
- Increasing intercultural awareness.

Students have the following opportunity under the Erasmus+ program:

- to perform part of study obligations at partner's universities in one of the participating countries of the Erasmus+ Program (see the list of EMUNI partner's institutions attached),
- to get work experiences as traineeships in companies from one of Erasmus+ eligible countries (company and country of traineeship are chosen and arranged by the student),
- to receive financial support under the Erasmus+ program (**Erasmus+ Mobility grant**).

EMUNI's students interested in the Erasmus+ Mobility for Studies and/or mobility for Traineeship (one student can apply for both), please send your motivational letter with subject Erasmus+ Mobility for Studies and/or Traineeship to [erasmus@emuni.si](mailto:erasmus@emuni.si).

- **Deadline for study mobility application for fall semester 2021/22 is 31 January 2021.**
- **Deadline for a traineeship mobility application for Academic year 2020/21 is 31. January 2021.**

### HOT TO APPLY?

The application to the call must contain following information:

- 1) A **motivation letter** (preferred institutions for a mobility, proposed plan of a mobility period – courses/training to be carried out and a preferred period of mobility)
- 2) Application Form<sup>1</sup> – filled in, signed and scanned

If there are no applications until the expiry of the call, the call remains open until the funds are used.

In case of a greater number of applications than available, EMUNI provides criteria for the selection of candidates:

- 1) Priority is given to candidates who have not yet gone to the ERASMUS+ Mobility,
- 2) The candidates are first classified according to the number of exams passed (number of ECTS). If they have the same number of ECTS, the average grade of all passed exams will be considered.
- 3) Priority for a traineeship mobility is given to the students, to whom in addition of the conditions of the points 1. and 2., also have a better traineeship programme prepared.

Applications will be reviewed and discussed by Erasmus Mobility Commission. The decision of selected candidates will be given within 14 days after the application deadline. A candidate can appeal to the decision of the commission within 7 days after receiving the decision.

Students with special needs are encouraged to apply for an ERASMUS+ Mobility.

### **Duration of the Mobility**

Study periods: from 3 to 12 months (including a complementary traineeship period, if planned).

Traineeships: from 2 to 12 months.

The same student may participate in mobility periods totalling up to 12 months maximum per each cycle of study, independently of the number and type of mobility activities.

### **Online Language Support (OLS)**

For a mobility where the main language of instruction or work is Bulgarian, Croatian, Czech, Danish, Dutch, English, Estonian, Finnish, French, German, Greek, Hungarian, Italian, Latvian, Lithuanian, Polish, Portuguese, Romanian, Slovak, Slovenian, Spanish or Swedish (or other languages available in the online language support tool) will be available for students to test their language skills through online language support.

## Mobility Grants

Participants are entitled to receive financial support in the form of a grant, which needs to be used to cover subsistence.

Calculation and payment of the final amount of the participant's grant is subject to the submission of all necessary supporting documents by the participant, as specified by the individual grant agreement signed with the participant prior to the mobility.

Students (**KA103**) undertaking mobility study in the following countries will receive these amounts per month:

Denmark, Finland, Iceland, Ireland, Luxemburg, Sweden, Great Britain, Lichenstein, Norway	520,00 €
Austria, Belgium, Germany, France, Italy, Greece, Spain, Cyprus, Netherlands, Malta, Portugal	470,00 €
Bulgaria, Croatia, Czech Republic, Estonia, Latvia, Lithuania, Hungary, Poland, Romania, Slovakia, North Macedonia, Turkey, Serbia, Slovenia	420,00 €

\*the amounts depend on the country where the activity takes place.

Students carrying out **traineeships** will receive an **additional top-up** from the EU grant to the amount of 100 EUR per month.

Additional funds are available for students with special needs. Eligible costs are the costs which are directly related to participants with special needs and their companions. A participant should provide a proof of costs (invoice).

Implementation of a physical mobility is subject of national and institutional regulations concerning COVID-19 pandemic.
