Applications

Please note the following information: as the Nursing degree is taught on two different campuses located in two different islands (São Miguel and Terceira), students may also be placed on Terceira Island. Courses in Clinical Teaching have limited places.

Required documents for admission for students (uploaded via our online system)

- OLA (Online Learning agreement) signed by the student and sending university (the UAc will only approve the OLA after the student submits the application);
- Colored photo (ID photo!);
- ID/Passport;
- European Health Insurance Card / International Health Insurance (for non-EU students);
- Language certificate (English B1 or Portuguese B1)

Language Requirements

At the UAc, the language of instruction is Portuguese. However, we provide a tutorial system in English to Erasmus students. Therefore, to communicate properly and attend classes successfully, it's important to have the following language proficiency upon arrival: Portuguese level B1 or English level B1.

Portuguese as a Foreign Language (PLE)

The UAc offers a Portuguese course (PLE), beginners level, to all Erasmus students. The course is available face-to-face for Ponta Delgada *campus* students and online for students of Angra do Heroísmo and Horta *campus*.

The PLE requires a minimum of 10 students to enrol, and it has an administrative fee, nonrefundable, of 25,00€, paid upon application.

Safety and Health

European Health Insurance Card, compulsory for all EU students (except Turkish). Private health insurance is also mandatory for non-European students.

Visa and residence permit

Non-EU students residing in non-EU countries must apply for a visa before arriving in Portugal. Non-EU students living in EU countries might not need to apply for a visa if they hold a valid Residence Permit issued by an EU country.
