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#### Vsebina:

- Spoznavanje z osnovnimi teksti in primeri, ki posegajo na področje digitalizacije in človekovih pravic.
- Preučevanje relevantnih zakonodajnih okvirov in etičnih vprašanj, povezanih z digitalizacijo.
- Udeležba na uvodnih delavnicah o osnovah digitalizacije in človekovih pravic.
- Predavanja o pomembnosti etičnega razmišljanja v digitalnem okolju in vpliv na človekove pravice.
- Priprava krajših raziskovalnih nalog ali esejev na temo digitalizacije in človekovih pravic.
- Analiza in predstavitev študijskih primerov, ki obravnavajo dileme na premislekih tehnologije in pravic.
- Individualni razgovori s kandidati, kjer bi predstavili svoje predhodne izkušnje, znanje in motivacijo za izbiro tega študija.
- Diskusija o aktualnih vprašanih digitalizacije in kako kandidati vidijo svojo vlogo pri obravnavanju teh izzivov.
- Ocenjevanje razumevanja ključnih konceptov in sposobnosti kritičnega razmišljanja ter preverjanje sposobnosti kandidata za sledenje akademskemu delu in raziskovanju na magistrskem nivoju na področju digitalizacije in človekovih pravic.
- Vodene refleksije, kjer bi kandidati razmislili o svojih osebnih in profesionalnih ciljih v povezavi s študijskim programom.

#### Content:

- Acquiring knowledge from basic texts and examples affecting the field of digitization and human rights.
- Examining relevant legislative frameworks and ethical issues related to digitization.
- Participation in introductory workshops on the basics of digitization and human rights.
- Lectures on the importance of ethical thinking in the digital environment and the impact on human rights.
- Preparation of short research papers or essays on the topic of digitization and human rights.
- Analysis and presentation of case studies that deal with dilemmas on considerations of technology and rights.
- Individual interviews with candidates, where they would present their previous experience, knowledge and motivation for choosing this study.
- Discussion on current digitalization issues and how the candidates see their role in addressing these challenges.
- Assessing understanding of key concepts and critical thinking skills and checking the candidate's ability to pursue academic work and research at master's level in the field of digitization and human rights.

- Samoevalvacija in izdelava načrta osebnega in strokovnega razvoja v kontekstu digitalizacije in človekovih pravic.

- Guided reflections, where candidates would reflect on their personal and professional goals in connection with the study program.
- Self-evaluation and creation of a personal and professional development plan in the context of digitization and human rights.
