ⁱ Tuition fees are paid by 2 instalments. First instalment has to be settled upon enrolment in amount of 65% of the tuition fee. Second instalment shall be paid by the end of February of the current academic year, in the amount of 35% of the tuition fee. 10% tuition fee discount for students enrolling through EKIC.

ⁱⁱ All items need to be paid upon the submission of the request, otherwise the request is considered insufficient.

ⁱⁱⁱ In case the candidate submits 2 requests at the same time (a request for the recognition of formal and informal forms of education), a higher fee for the recognition shall be considered and not the fee for both requests at the same time. The students, who submit the request for the recognition of formal education in the frame of the study exchange or the summer school, are exempt from paying the fee.

^{iv} If a candidate at the same time submits a request for the recognition of formal and non-formal education, he will be charged the higher of the applicable fees and not for both requests at the same time.

^v The fee is intended to cover material costs at the graduation ceremony (food and drink, entertainment, cultural program). The amount covers the costs for two accompanying persons.

^{vi} Fees of services do not include VAT.

^{vii} The decision is issued on the basis of the Assessment and Recognition of Education Act (OG. RS, no. 87/11, 97/11 - ex. and 109/12). The request for issuing a decision on the recognition of education obtained abroad for the purpose of continuing studies is free of charge.

^{viii} Elections to titles, which are in the interests of the Euro-Mediterranean University, may be exempt from paying upon the approval of the President / Management Board.
